

HUD approved homebuyer education/counseling is required to receive assistance from the Appleton Housing Authority. There are two local options:

1- FISC in Menasha offers Homebuyer Education & counseling in two parts. Part one (education) is completed online and part two (counseling) is an in-person budget appointment.

The total cost for both is \$150.00.

To take this course online, visit

www.financialeducationprograms.com/0306/. Click on the “Products” tab and choose “Make Your Move”. Once the online course is completed, contact FISC at 800-366-8161 to schedule the in-person budget appointment. The online course is available in English or Spanish.

2- NeighborWorks Green Bay offers homebuyer education in-person or online. Homebuyer counseling after the completion of the education is via phone or in-person. The counseling cost is included with the education.

The in-person classes are offered each month at their facility at 437 S. Jackson Street in Green Bay. Classes are available in English, Spanish, and Hmong. In-person homebuyer education is \$50 per household.

The cost for online Homebuyer Education is \$125 per household.
